

FAQs for parents/carers – Partial school closure

What are the dates of the partial school closure?

The school will be open only to children of key workers and those deemed vulnerable on Tuesday 5th January and Wednesday 6th January 2021. For all other children, the school are offering live lessons (times below) that they can access remotely. We will be reviewing the school situation again on Wednesday and update accordingly.

What time are the live lessons?

- Nursery – You will receive an email on your parent mail address with your child's learning for the day and further information.
- EYFS – All contact will be made through your child's email address. Please contact the school if you do not have these details. There are also resources that will be available to you and this will be detailed in the email.
- Year 1 & 2 – 9.15am phonics and literacy, 11am for maths and 1.45pm for wider curriculum. Teachers will also send a daily email with the day's work. Additional online access through Bug Club is also readily available.
- Year 3 & 4 – Lessons will be at 9am, 11am and 1.30pm, accessed through your child's email address.
- Year 5 & 6 – Lessons will be at 9am, 11am and 1.30pm, accessed through your child's email address.

Children will be expected to engage in their home learning. Lessons will be recorded so that families can access learning at a later time if needed – teachers will be taking registers of those children that are engaging with the workout during the day. Please note that children can access their learning on any device that can load the 'Teams' app.

Times of Day

If your child is coming in, then we will be sticking with their usual entrance and departure times. Please note they should use their usual gates for entry.

What classifies as a key worker?

Please note that if you are a key worker, we respectfully ask that you only send your child into school on the days that are really needed.

How do I get my child's password?

Please contact the school if you need your child's remote learning details. These were given out before Christmas and are in your child's home learning book.

Who will be in my child's bubble?

Where possible, your child will be in their usual class with their usual teacher or HLTA/TA. We are doing this to minimise any mixing of bubbles. If numbers are greater than 15 in any one class, then we may need to form an additional bubble to keep numbers low.

Will adults be mixing across bubbles?

Where possible, we will do all we can to minimise movement between bubbles as we always have.

Does my child need to wear uniform if they are attending the building?
